



# 1. Open Polish Platform of Medical Research

You can do this by typing into the search engine [www.ppm.gumed.edu.pl](http://www.ppm.gumed.edu.pl) or by clicking on the appropriate tab on the GUMed Main Library website.




## 2. Log in to your profile

To do this, click *Login* box visible in the upper right corner of the screen. Use the same login and password as you use for logging in into Extranet.






## 5. Authorize in ORCID

To do this, click *Authorize in ORCID* and log in to ORCID. In the next step, click *Authorize access*.


